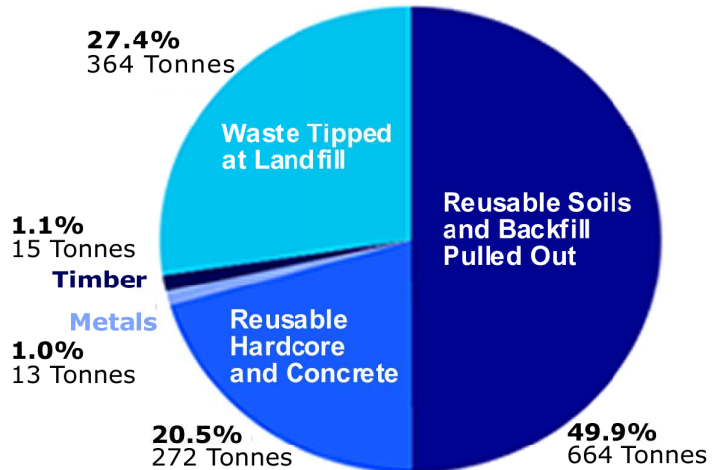

## What happens to your waste . . . . .

The diagram above shows waste being pre-selected via sorting grab on hydraulic material handler, then loading into the trommel hopper, where the material is graded via size into soils, after which passes under a magnet to remove ferrous metals, then through a bi-separation wind tunnel to remove useable hardcore and concrete products, thus leaving only lightweight paper and plastics for landfill. To add to this, plasterboard, wood and glass are seperated for recycling.

Current Landfill Regulations dictate that waste must be pre-treated before going to Landfill. We have invested heavily over the years to have equipment for waste separation and now have achieved enviable rates of recycling.

Sharp Transport have a waste management licence that enables us to handle up to 1,400 tonnes of general waste each week and sort waste to reduce landfill deposits substantially.
